# **DATA LAWS—GDPR**

The law regarding data protection is changing from May 2018. This will affect how we collate and store data as a church. As a first step in complying with the law we need to carry out an extensive data audit. To complete this

To complete this audit we need anyone who holds any leadership position in the Church, including PCC members, Ministry, youth, small group leaders, flower or cleaning teams etc, to let John Haslam know about any data they hold on anyone. This includes address, telephone number or email. He does not need to know specifically what data is held initially, but he will need to know what the data is used for, who has access to it and how it is stored. If you think this may mean that you need to speak to John, or even if you aren't quite sure but think you may need to - please speak to John Haslam who will be able to advise you.
