

The new GDPR regulations that became law in May 2018 also apply to churches. We have therefore produced a Data Privacy Notice detailing what data the Church holds and how that data is used. A copy of this notice has been put on the church notice board at the back of Church and it has been placed on the web site, individual copies can also be provided.

At the moment this is for information only. Under Church of England rules a totally new Electoral roll will have to be produced in 2019. We will be including a GDPR consent form with electoral roll forms during this time.

If anyone has any objections to the Church holding or using their Data in the manner described they have the right to ask that the Data is removed from our databases at any time.

COLLECTION

We do not pass a collection plate during our services - instead we have a basket near the church entrance where we ask people to place their gifts towards God's work. The work of the church depends upon the regular faithful giving of God's people and we encourage all who consider themselves members of Holy Trinity to give using envelopes or by standing order so that we can reclaim Gift Aid on their donations.
