Non-alcoholic juice is available instead of wine - just let those who are serving know. There are also gluten free wafers.

It can take quite a while for everyone to receive communion but it's good to keep an atmosphere of prayer whilst this is happening. So after you have received yourself please resist the temptation to chat to others and take the opportunity instead to be still and quiet, to reflect on the sermon, and to pray for others who are still going up to receive.
